Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to provide procedures for achieving the best possible student attendance results.

Scope:

This policy applies to all students and staff.

Guidelines:

1. The school will develop a range strategies and procedures to maximise attendance.
2. The school management will regularly review procedures against best practice.
3. The Principal will report to the board about attendance rates at least quarterly.
