Staff have been asked to submit areas of concern / need, that this funding could possibly be spent on. The majority of requests have been for air conditioning. This is still a work in progress with approval required from the MoE. D3 is, however, a Board owned building and cannot be part of the 5YA. The supported learning classes are using this building and the high temperatures in the room are of a concern. Karen asked that the BoT consider the purchase and installation of an air conditioning unit.</p> <p>Moved that the BoT approval the purchase and installation of air conditioning into D3 classroom. K.
