

## Whangārei Boys' High School Enrolment Information for 2022

The enrolment process for Year 9 entry to Whangārei Boys' High School in 2022 is now underway. We hope the information below will be of help to you in understanding how this process works.

Between Tuesday 27 July and Monday 2 August a school representative will visit the feeder schools in the area to meet with Year 8 students and hand out the school prospectus. This contains information about the school and an enrolment form.

Online enrolments can be completed by accessing the parent portal on our website and clicking on the enrolment tab. If you are unable to complete the enrolment online please use the green enrolment form included in the school prospectus.

Interviews this year will take place at Whangārei Boys' High School in Term 3. Please see dates below.

You will also need to bring copies of the following:

- ✓ Copy of Birth Certificate/Passport
- ✓ Evidence of address
- ✓ Copy of latest school report
- ✓ If you do not have NZ residency we will need to sight passports, student visa, and work permit documentation.

Baseline data for all students will be collected during the first week of Term 1, 2022. This week of school is designed to facilitate the transition into secondary school. It will be a Year 9 induction week, with Year 13 being the only other year level attending on the first day and prefects only on the Wednesday and Thursday in order to support the new Year 9s.

All junior classes are mixed ability groups with differentiation integrated into the learning activities. The make-up of these classes is based on a combination of the above data, school report, teacher feedback and enrolment interview. The more information we have the better, to enable us to best meet the needs of your son.
