

INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

Rationale:

We have students within our school that identify with our LGBTOOIA+ community.

In accordance with NELP objective 2 that <u>all</u> students have barrier free access to education.

Purpose:

To provide a safe and inclusive learning environment for LGBTQIA+ students.

Definitions:

LGBTQQIA+ is the acronym that refers to any person that identifies as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transexual, queer, questioning, intersex, asexual, allies, and more.

Scope:

This policy applies to all staff, students, family, and whanau.

Guidelines:

- 1. Create safe, inclusive environments with students (inclusive language, inclusive concepts, and inclusive values, provide an inclusive group for students that wish to attend).
- 2. Model inclusive behaviour (inclusive language, values and through addressing excluding behaviours).
- 3. Bullying and student targeting will be addressed and NOT tolerated.
- 4. A zero-tolerance approach to discriminatory or demeaning language in reference to LGBTQQIA+ students.
- 5. Provide professional learning opportunities for staff.
- 6. Maintain the privacy of all student information, including disclosures around diversity.
- 7. Gain consent from the student if students personal information needs to be shared.
- 8. Acknowledge and celebrate diversity.
- 9. Use pronouns preferred by student and include pronoun preference in enrolment form.
- 10. Have resources available for students (can be accessed online and/or at Te Awatea).
- 11. Analyze barriers to learning and achievement and develop strategies to meet the needs of individuals and groups.
